

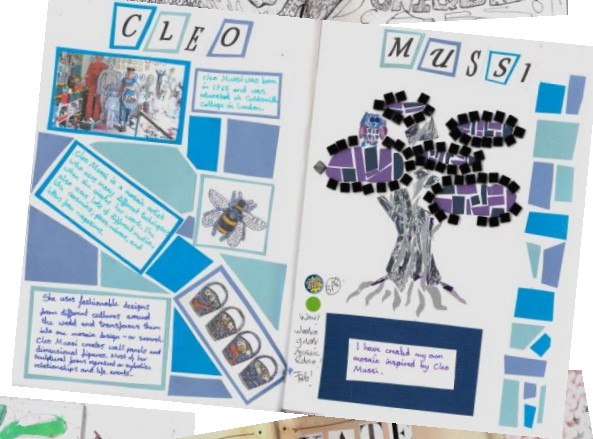

# How to create an artist page

Using **two whole pages** in your sketchbook you need to create an artist page. This should **tell us about the work** of an artist, *how it was created* and your **opinions of their work**.

You **must include the artist's** name (your teacher will tell you what artist to research) and **2 or 3 example images of their work**.

Look at the work of your artist and create an **exciting double page to communicate their work**. You want your artist page to be informative, **exciting** and relating to their work.

## Important things to remember:

- Don't forget the **artist's name** and **images of their work!**
- Your artist page should **fill two pages** in your book – you could use more pages or include *layers and flaps* to add more information.
- How about staining your pages first? Think about **composition** – will you mount your written information? How will you **present your images**?
- Look at the **style of the artist** and *present your page in this style*.
- How about using a similar **colour palette** to the artist's work?
- You could include **materials or techniques** that they use.
- **Have a go at making a response to the artist** – this means creating a piece of work in their style, using similar materials or techniques. You could try and copy a piece of their work – **this is a great way to learn new techniques!**
- Don't forget **to include your opinion of their work** – what does it make you think of?
