

# The school defines bullying as follows:

Behaviour by an individual or group usually repeated over time, that intentionally hurts another individual or group either physically or emotionally.

- 1. The definition and guidelines for student behaviour are posted throughout the school.
- 2. There is a clear procedure to follow should bullying occur and everyone knows what it is.
- 3. There is a support system for victims and survivors of bullying including the school counsellor and peer counselling service.
- 4. Non-aggressive behaviour is recognised through the rewards system.
- 5. There is a sanctions and support system for bullies, including counselling.

#### If you are being bullied:

In the first instance try to talk to your tutor, Head of House, Teachers, Welfare Support and parents/carers, then fill in a Bullying report.

If you feel uncomfortable talking to any of these, you can make a report on the **S**chool **H**elp **A**dvice **R**eporting **P**age or SHARP for short, this can be found on the home page of the school website.
