

Home School Agreement



The Governors and staff of Walton High School regard themselves as partners with parents in the education and the personal development of students. Parents of students entering the school are asked to enter into a partnership agreement with the school.

Walton High School will endeavour to:

- care for the wellbeing, happiness and safety of every student in school.
- provide support and guidance and offer help in case of financial hardship.
- ensure that the student achieves his/her full potential as a valued member of the school community in accordance with the school's equal opportunities policy.
- provide good teaching and a balanced programme of learning in accordance with National Curriculum requirements to meet individual needs.
- keep parents informed about school matters and provide regular progress reports.
- offer opportunities for family involvement in the life of the school.
- be receptive to parental concerns.
- be sensitive to the student's needs by listening and talking.
- provide and implement a code of conduct and an anti-bullying policy.
- provide opportunities for homework to be done at school.
- monitor the homework diary.

Parent / Carers

The school encourages parents / carers to:

- promote positive attitudes towards learning and a sense of pride in the school.
- listen and talk about their child's school day.
- ensure that their son/daughter attends school, on time and equipped for work.
- provide notes to explain any absence.
- provide the correct school uniform and encourage a smart appearance.
- support the school's homework policy and other opportunities for home learning e.g. by providing a suitable place to work, engage with the Classcharts Parent App to see what homework your child has received.
- try to attend parents' evenings and discussions about their son's/ daughter's progress.
- let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect the child's work or behaviour.
- support the school community in some way e.g. attending its events, taking out a covenant, giving professional advice, etc.
- attend school events/functions especially those in which their child participates.
- support the school's behaviour policy, code of conduct and anti-bullying agreement.
