First Week Arrangements

Arrangements for the first day of school in September 2025

First day – Tuesday 2nd September (school is open to Y7 and Y12 students only)

We will have a staggered start where pupils meet tutors outside reception then are taken into tutor.

Tutors 7.3 and 7.4 – **8.55am**

Tutors 7.5 and 7.6 – **9.05am**

Tutors 7.7 – **9.15am**

Tutors will meet and greet at reception, walk students to their tutor room and register. Year 7 assembly will follow at 9.30am

First Week Arrangements

Period 1 and 2 will be spent in tutor, students will receive their timetables and hopefully get to know each other with some ice breaker activities. Break will follow – thumb prints will not be set up at this point so students should bring a snack if they want one

Period 3 and 4 will be fire drill information, staggered thumb prints ahead of lunchtime and tutor tour around the school – students will meet key members of staff during this period as well.

Lunchtime– students will have the option to purchase food at lunchtime, or bring a packed lunch – make sure you have set your parent pay up ready to go.

Period 5 and P6 – student will be in their first lessons.

School finishes at 3.15pm

First Week Arrangements

Wednesday 3rd September – school starts at 8.40am.

Students will go straight to their tutor room. A warning bell sounds at 8.40am and students must be in their tutor by 8.45am.

During tutor time P1 and P2 we will have year group assemblies and tutor time to ensure students know where their first lessons are and how to get to them

Lessons will start P3.

If student have a PE lesson on the Wednesday, they will need PE kit.

Homework

- ▶ There is a homework timetable issued to each tutor group at the start of the year. This will be sent to parents in the first week, this is a guide of what students should expect to receive.
- ▶ Students usually receive approximately 2 subjects per night with approximately 20 mins to be spent on each subject. Sometimes students may not get homework, if for example they are working on a project in geography over a few weeks.
- ▶ Homework will be recorded on ClassCharts so you can keep a track on what your child has to do, and when it is due in.
